### **calls out for votes to bag a share of funds from Tesco Bags of Help**

Telford Infant School in Leamington Spa is bidding to bag a massive cash boost from the Tesco Bags of Help initiative. Tesco has teamed up with Groundwork to launch its community funding scheme, which sees grants of £4,000, £2,000 and £1,000 - raised from carrier bag sales in Tesco stores - being awarded to local community projects.

Three groups in every Tesco region have been shortlisted to receive a cash award and shoppers are being invited to head along to Tesco stores to vote for who they think should take away the top grant. Telford Infant School is one of the groups on the shortlist and would really appreciate your support.

Telford Infant School would like the cash boost to fund their 'Woodland Adventure Project' which aims to rejuvenate the school's outdoor wooded area to make it a safe, exciting learning environment. They would like a seated area to replace a broken part of the site; a fixed path so all children and adults can access the woods and the adventures within; a new outdoor fixed umbrella to provide shade all year round and, if possible, an outdoor mud kitchen to fuel the children's imagination!
