Visit Coventry Cathedral with an adult and explore the old ruins and new cathedral. Can you spot stained glass windows, crosses and symbols and sculptures? Draw your favourite part.	Go for a walk and make a list of the plants that you see. <i>Can you name the plants? What types of plants are they? Where are they growing? Can you talk about the plants' structure?</i>	Create a piece of art work inspired by Beatrix Potter. You could draw, paint or collage one of her famous animal characters.
