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Dear Parents and Carers

A very warm welcome to Reception!

Thank you for supporting us with the parent visits and bravely leaving your children at the classroom since they started. The children have settled well and are already showing us their independence in putting their coats, bags and water bottles away.

As parents, there is always a lot to take on board during the first few weeks and our aim is give you information as required. To help with this please always read the school newsletter to stay up to date about what is happening in school and look out for the reception emails on Fridayss. Sometimes we will also put posters outside our classroom doors, add quick reminders to Tapestry or ask the class PTA rep to add things to the class Facebook group (ran by parents not the school).

Please check that your child has the following items in school – please name EVERYTHING!

- Wellies (please pop on the welly rack outside the classroom)
- Spare clothes in a suitable bag that can hang on their peg (these stay in school unless used)

Each day your child should bring with them;

- Coat (we go outside a lot and the weather is very changeable)
- Water bottle (please fill before coming to school but do not put in book bags as bottles can leak)
- Book bag (even though there might not be much in it yet the children need to practise putting it away and looking after it)

Toileting accidents – if your child has a toileting accident they will be encouraged to change themselves with supervision. If your child needs support, a member of staff will wear the appropriate PPE to support them. Wet or soiled clothes will be bagged and given to you at the end of the day together with a toileting slip. Curriculum - this half term we are spending the first few weeks getting to know your children and finding out what they can do and what their interests are. Please look at the observations on Tapestry on a regular basis and continue to upload your own from home. This provides us with a rounded view of your child. Please read our Autumn 1 Curriculum news to find out more about the learning your children will be focusing on this half term.

Pick up and drop off - please ensure that you are using the one way system for everyone's safety. Please do not let your child ride bikes or scooters when on the school site, this is to keep everyone safe.

Birthdays - we love to celebrate birthdays at school. If you would like to you can send a birthday book into school to keep in your child's class library. Please do not send in sweets or cake as we have several children in school with food allergies who cannot share such treats.

Pirate ship – we are very lucky to have a fantastic pirate ship on our front playground. Due insurance children cannot play on this before or after school.

Outdoor classroom – our reception outdoor classroom is outside Magenta classroom – the children love using this space, and in order to be ready to teach this area is set up in the morning before school starts. Whilst it looks very inviting, we ask that reception children younger siblings do not play with the resources in this area before or after school.

Eschools – this is our school communication system and you have received a login for this. Please activate your account asap.

Parent pay - this is how you pay for items such as school trips, PTA events etc and you have received a login for this. Please activate your account asap.
