

Below are a few ideas of how you might use the resources in the phonics support pack.

MATCHING PAIRS – using two sets of sounds/ phonemes spread them out upside down. Take it in turns to turn two over, say the sound/ phoneme. If it matches you keep the pair and have another go.

BINGO - create a simple Bingo card with some of the sounds or words containing the phonemes. Take it in turns to be Bingo caller! (*The children have been shown how to blend simple words using the phonemes in this pack along with phonemes from the previous pack eg z-i-p, ch-o-p, qu-i-ck, b-u-zz-i-ng

RAINBOW WRITE - write a sound/ tricky word in yellow. The children can trace over in as many colours as they want to create a rainbow.

RUN AROUND - hide sounds/ words around the house or garden. Challenge the children to find the ones you are asking for.

NOUGHTS AND CROSSES - choose a sound/ word each. Fill in a noughts and crosses grid with the sounds/ words rather than the '0' and 'X'.
