

ATTENDANCE AUDIT

Yesterday morning we underwent a school attendance audit led by a member of the Warwickshire Attendance, Compliance and Enforcement (ACE) Service who scrutinised attendance levels as well as our processes for monitoring and managing attendance and punctuality.

ACE were very complimentary about the systems we have established and are confident that we are commitmed to maximise attendance for every child.

Concerns were raised about a small number of children whose attendance is below 90% and a small number of children who are persistently late and we were advised to continue to work with those families involved. If you are ever concerned about your child's attendance please do not hesitate to ask us for support.

ATTENDANCE FACTS

- There are 190 school days each year and 175 other days for shopping trips, birthday treats, non urgent appointments and holidays.
- One day a week absence is the equivalent over a school career of 2.5 whole years of education missed.
- 10 days holiday leave a year is the equivalent of two whole terms of education missed.
- 15 minutes of lateness a day equals one whole year of education missed.
