## **END OF YEAR REPORTS**

This is advance notice that at 9am on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> July your child's report will be available for you on your child's Tapestry account. Please ensure you download this if you would like to keep a copy.

Please note that normally at the end of Year One your child's performance in the Year One phonics screening is included in their report. However, due to COVID-19 the government has suspended all statutory assessments for this year. The reported assessment you will see for phonics is a teacher assessment based on whether your child is working towards phase 5 or working within phase 5. There is no greater depth assessment for phonics.
