Dear Parents and Carers of children in Year 1 and Year 2,

Positive case of COVID-19 in Reception

Year 1 and Year 2 children are NOT considered a close contact to this case.

We have been advised that there has been a confirmed case of COVID-19 in Reception. I am writing to let you know that your child has not been in close contact with the affected case during school time and you do not need to take any action unless told otherwise by NHS Test and Trace.

Parents who helped during the Reception PTA Present Room on 2nd December

Parents in school helping with the Reception PTA Present Room may also wish to take a PCR test if they were in close contact with Reception pupils. The definition of close contact is as follows:

- *face-to-face contact including being coughed on or having a face-to-face conversation within one metre*
- *been within one metre for one minute or longer without face-to-face contact*
- *been within 2 metres of someone for more than 15 minutes*

What to do if your child develops symptoms of COVID-19

The most common symptoms of COVID-19 are recent onset of:

- new continuous cough and/or
- high temperature and/or
- a loss of, or change in, normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)

If your child develops any of these symptoms of COVID-19, they should remain at home and arrangements should be made for them to be tested. This should be a test taken at an NHS site (PCR test) and NOT a rapid test taken at a community testing site (LFT test). At that time, household members who are over 18 years and 6 months and not fully vaccinated, must also stay at home, not go to work, school or public areas, even for exercise.
