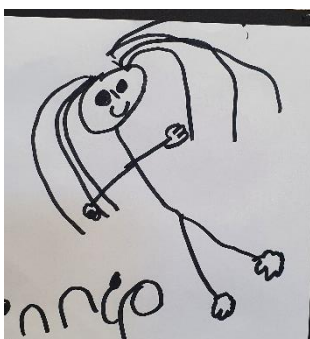
NATIONAL TEACHING ASSISTANT DAY

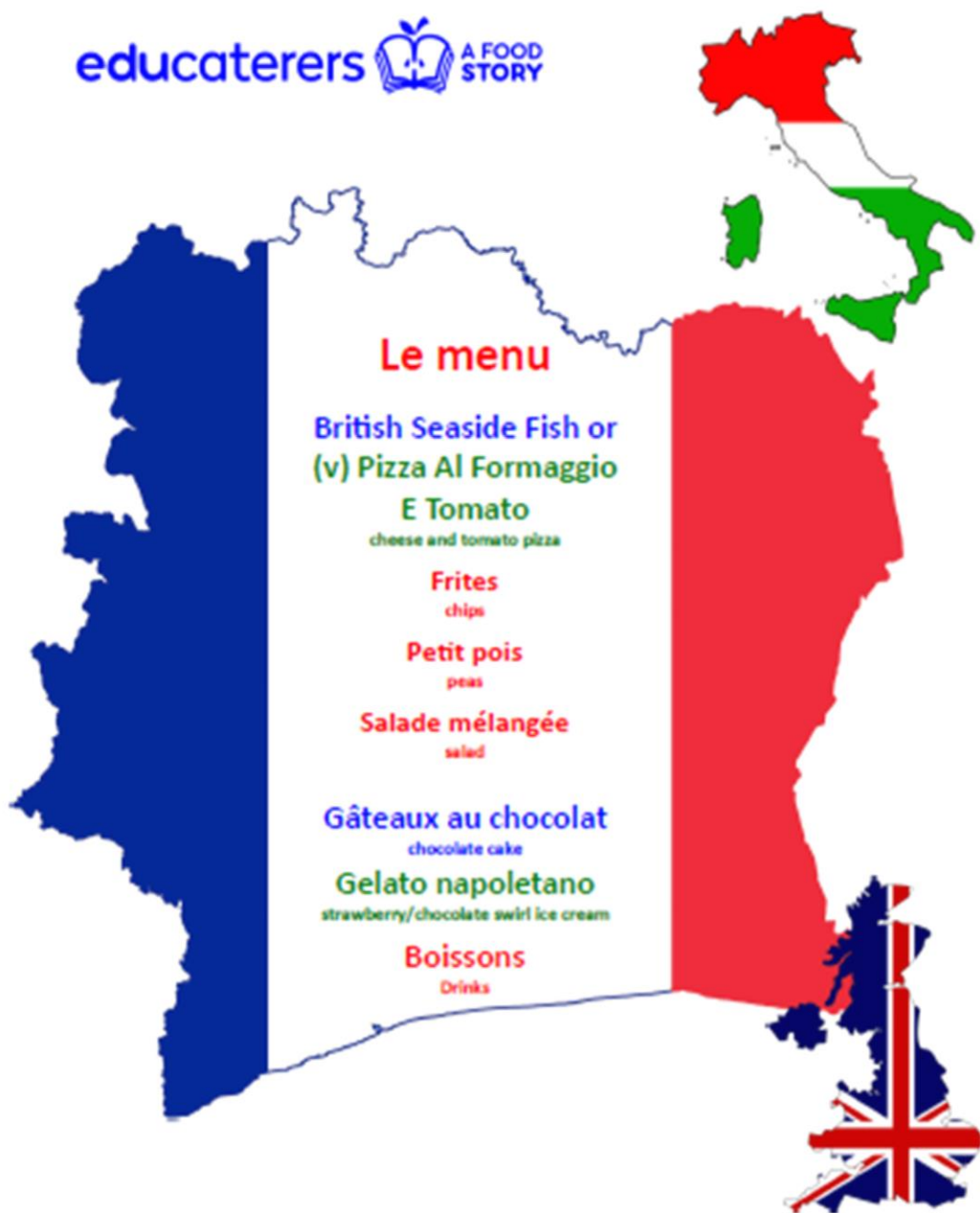
