#### **RETURN TO SCHOOL**

The relaxation of COVID-19 restrictions means that school life will be changing again for us all. A new Risk Assessment has been created and this will be published on our website early next week. Our initial arrangements will be in place throughout September and will be reviewed after 4 weeks.

#### **Key information for parents:**

\*Many control measures remain in place, eg. handwashing, cleaning regimes, ventilation, staff LFD testing.

\*Bubbles no longer exist but year groups will be kept broadly separate at the start of term while the children settle down in their new year groups and get used to unfamiliar routines eg. lunch in the hall, face to face assemblies.

\*Face masks and social distancing rules have been relaxed however Warwickshire LA guidance states: 'We would recommend that parents continue to wear face coverings on the school site when dropping off and picking up children.' and 'We recommend that you continue to encourage social distancing where possible.' You are likely to see most staff wearing masks during drop off and collection times.

\*Children with the 3 main symptoms of COVID-19 must not be brought into school, please contact us

\*If there is a positive case in school then NHS Track and Trace will be responsible for getting in touch with close contacts. Children will not need to self-isolate unless they have the 3 main COVID-19 symptoms or have a positive test result – Remote Learning will be provided by the school.

\*The Local Authority guidance also states that schools should: 'avoid bringing parents onto the school site other than to drop off and pick up their children. Where a meeting is required this should be done online if possible.'

We shall review this at the end of September and very much hope that we shall be able to open our doors to you very soon.

\*SMILES is back up and running. We are contacting our other After School Club providers and will be reintroducing a variety of clubs shortly.

We shall keep you updated as things progress.

#### **REMINDER – YEAR 1 AND 2**

On Friday 10<sup>th</sup> September Year 1 and 2 children (and staff!) are invited to come to school in party clothes or in 1960s themed clothing. Please ensure your child wears sensible shoes and brings a coat if the weather is cold and/or rainy.
