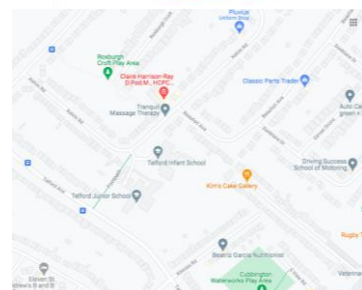


Autumn 2 – All Around Me Year 1 Optional home learning

This is a takeaway menu of home learning for you and your child to choose from should you wish to complete any home learning. Please share any of the activities that you complete with us on Tapestry.



Log on to your Education City account (details on Tapestry) and practise your maths skills by completing the activities that have been allocated to your account.

We will be learning about a local artist, Paul Horton, who creates paintings that feature buildings and street scenes. Use the internet to look at some of his work and then see if you can recreate a piece.



Set up a shop at home. This could be a toy shop, grocery shop, café or book shop. Create some price labels. Take it in turns to be the shop keeper and customer. Practise using coins, making different totals and giving change.

Go on a materials hunt around your house. How many different items can you find made out of paper, wood, metal, fabric, plastics and cardboard? Create a list by drawing the objects and labelling the objects with their name and the material that they are made from.

With a grownup, go for a walk in the local area around Telford Infant School. How many different types of buildings can you see? What are they used for? How are the buildings the same and how are they different? Take some photographs of the different buildings that you see.

Write a letter to a friend or family member to share some news with them. Remember to include the address of the person writing it, the date, the name of who the letter is to and the name of who the letter is from – you.
