This year Telford Infant School are very excited to have signed up to the Warwickshire Safe and Active travel award programme.

Reception have already had a visit from Road Safety officer Louise along with help from 'Warwick the Bear' Together they played games and learned all about how to stay safe near roads. They learnt the importance of walking with grown- ups and to 'stop, look, listen and hold hands when they cross the road.



In February Year 2 will have a face to face lesson with their road safety officer called 'Scooter Safety' and Year 1 will be Road Safety Spies and will access their learning via on line resources during the year.
