SENDING LEARNING HOME

Over next few weeks children will come home with work that has been completed throughout the year. Please be reassured that all items sent home will have been quarantined for a minimum of 72 hours.

ROAD CLOSURE

The school has been informed that there will be a road closure in place on Leicester Lane near Cubbington between Monday 12 July and Thursday 22 July including weekends subject to consent.

The closure will be in place between 9:30am and 3:30pm each day including weekends with workers on site one hour before and one hour after the works to set up and secure the site at the end of each day.

REMINDER - WHAT WOULD HAPPEN IN THE EVENT OF A BUBBLE CLOSURE DUE TO A POSITIVE CASE OF COVID-19

HOW WE WILL INFORM YOU IF YOUR CHILD NEEDS TO SELF ISOLATE

Should a pupil or staff member receive a positive test for COVID-19 and, under the advice of Public Health England, your child is identified as needing to self isolate the following will happen:

*If your child is already in school and needs to self isolate, you will be alerted by text and asked to collect your child as soon as possible.

*If we find out that we need to close a bubble outside of school hours and your child needs to self isolate you will receive a text informing you of this and letting you know that your child should not be brought into school.

This will be followed up as soon as possible afterwards by a letter sent to you on eschools. Parents of children who do not need to self isolate will also be informed through eschools that a positive case has resulted in a bubble closure.
