MESSAGE FROM CHAIR OF GOVERNORS OUR SCHOOL BUDGET

The last year has been a difficult one financially for us. You may recall that I wrote to you about a year ago to explain that, along with other local schools, we were going to have to make cuts to some of our provision and staffing. Those cuts were made and although the staff worked hard to give your children a first class education it was a tough year. The PTA and many families have been incredibly generous in donating resources and money to help ease the strain, so thank you very much for that.

This year our budget has improved slightly, meaning that we will be able to offer your children a little more support, but we are still not back to the levels of funding that we were receiving previously. If you are able to continue to support the school through taking part in PTA events, making small donations of resources and letting our politicians know your views about the level of school funding that would be fantastic.

ATTENDANCE – EVERY SCHOOL DAY COUNTS! Whole School Attendance up to 19th April 2018 – 97.3%

As soon as an individual child's absence falls below 90% they fall into a recorded category called persistent absence as it then means that they are missing at least 1/2 a day of school every week - time which is then very difficult to catch up.

There will be some changes to the entrance points into school on Kelvin Road and further details will follow as the work commences.

We do still receive unwanted visitors out of school hours and anticipate that the security fencing will solve this. In the meantime we ask that you call Learnington Police if you see anyone trespassing. Following the arson attacks last term the police react very quickly to any concerns we have.

The Local Authority has also installed a new CCTV system at the back of school during the Easter break. We now have excellent coverage of the back playground and garden area.
