



Year group of child (156 responses)




My child has settled into their new year group well. (160 responses)







I know how to help my child with their homework. (160 responses)





You said	We are doing
Too much advertising and junk mail is sent out.	We are talking to our community partners about receiving information electronically where possible.
There is too much homework. and There is not enough homework.	Year 2 are trialling a take away home learning system, where children complete short and long tasks of their choice over a set number of weeks. This gives the choice and control to you. We will let you know the outcome of this trial in the New Year. Reception are also using a similar approach for their optional home learning.
The new morning routines are good but it can be tricky for the children to enter the classroom when other parents are talking to the teacher at the door.	If you wish to speak to the class teacher about something which needs a longer discussion than a quick message, please book an appointment to see them via the office. Class teachers are continuing to ensure all children can enter the classroom easily and settle at a task quickly. Reception children are settling quicker and more parents are able to leave promptly. We will continue to monitor this.
First aid notes are not always found by you until a few days after the event or children loose them.	First aid notes are now passed directly to the class teacher who will give them to the person collecting your child at the end of the day or pass them to the club they are attending (who will give them to you).
