

TRANSITION DAY – THURSDAY 27TH JUNE 2019

INFORMATION FOR PARENTS



Arrangements for transition Day next Thursday are as follows:

Current Reception and Year 1 children - should be dropped off and collected from their current classrooms. They will spend between 10am and 2.30pm with their new teacher in their new classroom. Their new teaching assistant will also be with them in the morning. At the end of the day they will bring home a slip of paper detailing their new classroom, class name and photos of their teacher and teaching assistant.

At the end of the day you should collect your child from their usual classroom – or children will be taken as normal to SMILES or our other after school clubs.

If you would like to have a quick look at your child's new classroom you are welcome to visit (through the external classroom door) between 3.30pm and 3.45pm where the new class teacher will be pleased to meet you.

Please note that this is a chance to say a quick hello and we understand that not all parents are available at the end of the day. Welcome Meetings for Year 1 and Year 2 parents will take place very early in the Autumn term when you will be invited to join us to share information about the coming new school year. Dates of these meetings will follow.

Current Year 2 children – should be dropped off and collected from their current classrooms at Telford Infants. They will spend between 10am and 2.30pm at the Junior School and will stay for lunch which will be provided by ourselves. Infant School Midday Supervisors will be on hand to support them during the lunch break at Juniors on this day. If your child is not moving to the Junior School in September please bring your child into school as normal - we have lots of activities planned for them and their Year 2 teachers really appreciate having them as their special helpers and ambassadors for Year 2 for the day.

We do our very best to make transition as happy and smooth as possible for all our children and we are sure the children will have a wonderful time preparing for their time in their new classes. Other transition opportunities will also follow for the children before the summer break.
