#### Reading

Thank you for ensuring that your child's reading book is in school every day and for keeping us updated on how your child is getting on with their reading at home via Tapestry. Reading is an essential building block for all learning and we would like to urge you to listen to your child read as often as possible. Please remember your child can change their reading book by putting their wallet (with book inside) in the 'reading books to be changed' box in their classroom on a **Tuesday** and/ or **Friday**. Even if your child has not finished a book, please ensure that they have their reading book in school every day. In school they will read with an adult as part of a guided reading group once a week.

#### **Tapestry**

We will continue to use Tapestry as a way to share information about the learning that we have done in school with you. Your child's class teacher, or a teaching assistant, will add a reading comment onto your child's account when they have completed a reading session with your child. We also upload weekly phonics activities onto Tapestry which will reinforce the phonics learning that your child has received during the week, should you choose to complete them at home. In addition to this, we may also add extra activities and resources onto Tapestry from time to time. We will use the memos section of Tapestry if we need to relay any generic year group messages to you or share any key news.

## pecial days

We always try to celebrate special days and events in school to ensure the children learn about a broad range of topics. This half term we will be celebrating Children in Need, Remembrance Day and Christmas.

## Outdoor classroom

Please make sure that your child brings a warm, waterproof coat to school throughout the winter months, both for playtimes, and to enable us to learn outside if appropriate.

Please make sure that your child has a named PE kit (including jogging bottoms, jumper and pumps or trainers) in school every day as PE days can often change. In Year 1 PE is mainly in the afternoons.
