# TELFORD INFANT SCHOOL



Dear Parents and Carers,

The government guidance for the full opening of schools in September was published at the end of last week. A new Risk Assessment for full reopening is in the process of being completed and plans are almost finalised for the reopening for all pupils on a full time basis.

Planning to reopen is proving neither an easy nor a quick task as strict Covid-19 secure measures will need to remain in place and be developed further to reduce the risk of transmission to a school with significantly higher numbers of children compared to recent weeks.

At the time of writing I am waiting for Local Authority confirmation as to the viability of a key aspect of our plan and I am preparing for the first of two governor meetings this evening to begin the process of ratifying our proposals.

Sarah Boad, our Chair of Governors, and I will write to you next week with full details of what this means for your child but in the meantime I can confirm that unless government guidance for schools changes in response to the Covid-19 situation:

\*Telford Infants will be fully open for all Year 1 and Year 2 children from Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> September. \*Our new Reception children will visit us during week 1, attend part time during week 2 and will be in school on a full time basis from Monday 14th September. Further details will be sent to new Reception parents. \*In line with government guidance the children will continue to be placed in bubbles but these bubbles will be larger than the current cap of 15 children. Children will not mix with other children from other bubbles. \*There will be staggered start and end times for the school day and a one way system for dropping off and collecting children from their classroom doors. \*Children will receive full teaching time. Whilst there will be a need for 'catch up' we will continue to provide a broad and balanced and ambitious curriculum. \*We are also working on plans to reopen SMILES.



\*Should bubbles close due to a positive case of Covid-19 we will offer remote education to all children in that bubble.

\*Should there be a national or local lockdown then we will be in a position to provide continuity of education for keyworkers and vulnerable children in school and for all other pupils remotely.

The government has confirmed that 'school attendance will be mandatory again from the start of the Autumn term' and that 'the majority of pupils will be able to return to school.' If your child is unlikely to be unable to return to school in September due to a medical condition and on the basis of recent advice from their medical professional I would be very grateful if you would email me before the end of next week on

admin2326@welearn365.com so that we can ensure that the necessary arrangements are put in place to continue their education.

I am so excited about the prospect of having a school full of children back in September – **my only sadness** is that this will not include the current Year 2 children.

Thank you for your ongoing support and patience in these very strange times. Mrs Boad and I will be in touch with you as soon as we are in a position to do so. Mrs Siân Oustayiannis - Headteacher
