




Spring 1 – To Infinity and Beyond

<p>Research a famous astronaut and make a poster about them. You could use non-fiction books or the internet to find out some facts. Think about how you could present the information. Can you add pictures or appropriate decoration to your poster to make people want to read it?</p> 	<p>How many things can you find at home made from the following materials; plastic, wood, metal, rubber and glass? Can you write a list of the items? Can you record the number of items that you find in a tally? Can you turn that tally chart into a bar chart?</p> <p>Grownups – We have learnt how to create tally charts and bar charts in school during the autumn term so hopefully the children can show you what they remember.</p>	<p>Wrap up warm and go on a winter welly walk with your family. What signs of winter can you see? What differences can you spot around you from when you were outside in the autumn time?
