INFORMING SCHOOL OF POSITIVE **COVID-19 TEST RESULTS DURING** THE CHRISTMAS HOLIDAYS

If your child becomes poorly over the Christmas break and you get them tested for COVID-19 please alert us via email admin2326@welearn365.com if the date that symptoms first started - or, if asymptomatic, the date of the Covid test was Saturday 19 December or before this date.

If the date of first symptoms - or, if asymptomatic the date of the test - was **Sunday 20 December or after this** date, there is no need to let us know.

The DfE has told schools to be on standby for contact tracing for 6 days and the school admin email will be checked for COVID related messages (as outlined above) up to and including Wednesday 23rd December.

Please note that the school answerphone will not be monitored between Saturday 19th December and Sunday 3rd January.

If your child is unable to attend school for any reason on first day of the new term on Tuesday 5th January please contact us by phone or by email on Monday 4th or first thing on Tuesday 5th.

The school office will go back to normal hours - manned between 8am and 4pm from Monday 4th January.
