Dear Reception Parents and Carers,

END OF YEAR REPORTS

This is advance notice that at 9am on 15th July your child's report will be available for you on Tapestry. Please ensure you download this before Reception Tapestry accounts close on 21st July.

Normally at the end of the Reception year, a judgement against the Early Learning Goals (ELGs) is made before the children move to work under the National Curriculum in Year 1. However, due to COVID-19 the government has suspended all statutory assessments for this year.

Your child's report includes an overview of the 'Characteristics of Effective Learning'. Judgements here are made based on how the children work **independently** and across a wide range of activities and situations. The yellow highlight indicates the areas which your child demonstrates this characteristic **consistently**. An un-highlighted box does not mean they do not demonstrate these characteristics, but, that as practitioners, we do not feel we have seen this as embedded in their approach to their learning.
