Dear Parents and Carers of children in Reception and Year 1,

Positive case of COVID-19 in school

For information - Your child is NOT considered a close contact to this case.

- Parents and carers supporting the Visit to church on Thursday 14th October are also NOT considered close contacts.

We have been advised that there has been a confirmed case of COVID-19 in Year 2. I am writing to let you know that your child has not been in close contact with the affected case during school time and you do not need to take any action unless told otherwise by NHS Test and Trace.

What to do if your child develops symptoms of COVID-19

The most common symptoms of COVID-19 are recent onset of:

- new continuous cough and/or
- high temperature and/or
- a loss of, or change in, normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)

If your child develops any of these symptoms of COVID-19, they should remain at home and arrangements should be made for them to be tested. This should be a test taken at an NHS site (PCR test) and NOT a rapid test taken at a community testing site (LFT test). At that time, household members who are over 18 years and 6 months and not fully vaccinated, must also stay at home, not go to work, school or public areas, even for exercise.
