Tickets are on sale outside the main school office after school today and at drop off time tomorrow morning!Lots of chocolate treats and a Chocolate Easter Cake to be won!


The raffle will be drawn on Friday 12th and prizes sent home after school with the lucky winners!

SPONSORED BOUNCE




Poppy's Poster – Telford Infant Reception winner
