First of all, thank you for all the support you are providing your child so that they can continue learning at home. We have seen lots of amazing learning posted on tapestry! We hope you are enjoying the topics, learning ideas and prerecorded lessons we are providing. - You must be with your child during the 10 minute session (but you don't need to be on camera!)
- Your child should be sat in a suitable place in the home
- Your child must maintain the standard of behaviour expected in school
- Your child must be wearing suitable clothing with their school jumper over their own clothes

We hope this addition to our remote learning offer will help us feel more connected whilst the children cannot come to school.
