COVID-19 TESTING - REMINDER Testing if your child has symptoms

If your child displays one or more of the main 3 COVID-19 symptoms they must not be brought into school and they must be taken for a full PCR COVID-19 test. If the PCR test is negative your child can return to school with immediate effect.

The 3 main symptoms – as outlined by the NHS are:

- a high temperature this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back
- a new, continuous cough this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal.

If your child develops one of these symptoms in school we will contact you for immediate collection and a PCR test.

Asymptomatic Testing

Lateral Flow tests – the faster tests that give a result in around 30 minutes – are for testing in people who do not have one of the main 3 symptoms. Families are being offered Lateral Flow Tests tests to help find more cases of COVID-19 and to try and break any chains of transmission.
