Design and make a new toy. You could use junk modelling, playdough, construction kits, anything you like!	We will be learning about a famous piece of Japanese artwork called 'The Great Wave.' Have a go at recreating it in felt tips, paint, wax crayons or chalk etc.	Set up a toy shop at home. Create some price labels. Take it in turns to be the shop keeper and customer. Practise using coins, making different totals and giving change.
Create a repeating pattern using paint, crayons, felt tips, shapes – anything! Be creative.	Find out about a toy that your grownups at home, or your grandparents used to play with when they were little. What was it called? What did it do? What was it made from?	Write a story featuring your favourite toy as the main character.
