Underwear – pants, socks and tights – for little accidents that occur in school from time to time. We are particularly short of larger sizes (up to 7-8 years).

COVID-19

The government guidance related to COVID-19 testing and self isolation is changing regularly. Current guidance related to when your child can and cannot attend school is as follows:

Can attend:

*If you child is a close contact to a positive case they can attend school – the guidance is for them to take daily lateral flow tests for 7 days.

Can't attend:

*If your child has one of the 3 main symptoms – cough, temperature, loss of sense of taste/smell – they must self isolate and should take a PCR test. *If your child does not have symptoms but tests positive following a lateral flow test they must self isolate immediately but are not required to take a confirmatory PCR test.

If in any doubt as to whether your child can come into school please do contact the school office – phones are manned between 8am and 4pm.

Changes to the self-isolation period for those who test positive for COVID-19: From Monday 17 January, people who are self-isolating with COVID-19 will have the option to reduce their isolation period after 5 full days if they test negative with a LFT on both day 5 and day 6 and they do not have a temperature. For example, if they test negative on the morning of day 5 and the morning of day 6, they can return to their education or childcare setting immediately on day 6.
